

**Carlisle Fire Department
Volunteer Position Description
Rescue Services**

The primary function of a Rescue Services is to protect the community from disaster situations, including vehicle and water rescue, and rescue from building collapse, trench collapse, confined space collapse and high angle rescue. This position also provides traffic control at incidents.

Essential Functions

Essential Functions are not intended to be an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties and skills. They are intended to be accurate summaries of what the job classification involves and what is required to perform it.

- Responds to rescue incidents to remove victims from vehicles, building collapse, trench collapse, confined space collapse and other rescues;
- Responds to water rescue;
- Responds to calls for emergency medical services, and renders first aid;
- Responds to and renders assistance in emergency cases;
- Cleans and inspects equipment and apparatus after returning from a rescue;
- Inspects equipment and apparatus and notifies superior officer of any defects;
- Keeps fire station, equipment and grounds in a clean and orderly condition;
- Participates in training activities and instruction sessions;
- Acquires and retains a thorough knowledge of the Borough, including streets, buildings, water supply, unusual hazards and related items;
- Performs various public information or education tasks;
- Enters inspection, training and (on occasion) rescue and emergency medical service calls into the records management systems;
- Performs all work duties and activities in accordance with Standard Operating Policies and Procedures;
- Works in a safe manner and reports unsafe activity and conditions.

Other Duties and Responsibilities:

- May respond to emergency calls for specialized service such as confined spaces rescue, extrication and technical rescues that include high angle, below grade, swift water, trench and collapse rescues;
- Deals with social service related areas of emergency response by assisting victims and relatives of victims of traumatic events.

Knowledge Skills and Abilities

Knowledge of:

- The geography of the Borough of Carlisle and surrounding areas, (or the ability to quickly learn this information), including the streets system, hydrant locations, the layout and location of public utilities and potentially hazardous materials or substances;
- Specialized rescue and boating equipment;
- Current strategies for all types of water, vehicle, confined space, high angle and building collapse rescue techniques.
- Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) techniques and related medical equipment;
- Basic mathematical and science skills;
- Emergency response records systems, communications equipment and use, fire computer applications and incident reporting procedures;
- Computers and related software.

Ability to:

- Make determinations as to the best course of action for responding to rescue related emergency situations;
- Work under extremely stressful situations, day and night, which result from an emergencies, including the responsibility for remaining calm and carrying out all duties with the recognition of the threat to life and property;
- Successfully meet the Carlisle Fire Company requirements and pass entry exams;
- Work within a command structure requiring strict adherence to the following of orders;
- Work in a team environment under extremely stressful situations;
- Quickly learn and put to use new skills and knowledge brought about by rapidly changing information and/or technology;
- Learn and correctly apply routine policies and procedures;
- Read, comprehend, and follow simple oral and written instructions; and to understand and apply available guidelines to varied operational requirements;
- Perform a wide variety of duties and responsibilities with accuracy and speed under the pressure of time-sensitive deadlines;
- Demonstrate integrity, ingenuity and inventiveness in the performance of assigned tasks;
- Operate a personal computer using program applications appropriate to assigned duties;
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing, with the public and other Firefighters and Rescue Personnel.

Minimum Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED equivalency; and
- Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of application;
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge and abilities necessary to perform the work.

Essential Physical Abilities

The primary duties are performed in a work environment in which the Rescuer is subject to potential personal danger. Therefore, the following physical abilities are deemed essential:

- Sufficient clarity of speech and hearing and other communication capabilities, with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Rescuer to communicate effectively, including during emergency situations which may involve a high degree of noise;
- Sufficient vision and other powers of observation, with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Rescuer to effectively operate at an emergency scene;
- Sufficient manual dexterity with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Rescuer to operate equipment used in a rescue;
- Sufficient personal mobility and physical reflexes, with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Rescuer to perform all duties involved in protecting life and property.
