

**Carlisle Fire Department
Volunteer Position Description
Wildland/Brush Firefighter**

The primary function of a Wildland/Brush Firefighter is to protect the community from outdoor disasters including tree and brush fire situations and promote an environment of public safety within the Borough of Carlisle's Fire Department's response area. The position is primarily focused on the out of doors. This position also participates in fire prevention activities, equipment and quarter's maintenance, and training dealing with all phases of fire suppression, prevention, inspection, rescue and emergency operation.

Essential Functions

Essential Functions are not intended to be an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties and skills. They are intended to be accurate summaries of what the job classification involves and what is required to perform it.

- Responds to brush and wild fire alarms and extinguishes fire;
- Prepares fire breaks including rock and brush removal;
- Responds to calls for emergency medical services, and renders first aid;
- Operates mowers, chainsaws and other tree and brush removal equipment;
- Cleans and inspects equipment and apparatus after returning from a fire;
- Inspects equipment and apparatus and notifies superior officer of any defects;
- Makes minor repairs to equipment and apparatus, performs routine preventative maintenance tasks, and keeps records of such action;
- Keeps fire station, equipment and grounds in a clean and orderly condition;
- Participates in training activities and instruction sessions;
- Acquires and retains a thorough knowledge of the Borough, including parks and natural areas subject to brush fires;
- Performs various public information or education tasks;
- Enters inspection, training and (on occasion) fire and emergency medical service calls into the records management systems;
- Performs all work duties and activities in accordance with Standard Operating Policies and Procedures;
- Works in a safe manner and reports unsafe activity and conditions.

Other Duties and Responsibilities:

- May work with federal and state agencies with jurisdictions over natural environments.
- Deals with social service related areas of emergency response by assisting victims and relatives of victims of traumatic events.

Knowledge Skills and Abilities

- The geography of the Borough of Carlisle and surrounding areas, (or the ability to quickly learn this information), including the streets system, hydrant locations, location of natural areas and parks.
- Specialized brush and wild fire fighting vehicles and equipment;
- Current strategies for wild-land and brush fires;
- Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) techniques and related medical equipment;
- Basic mathematical and science skills;
- Emergency response records systems, communications equipment and use, fire computer applications and incident reporting procedures;
- Computers and related software.

Ability to:

- Make determinations as to the best course of action for fighting fires or responding to other related emergency situations;
- Work under extremely stressful situations, day and night, which result from a fire and other emergencies, including the responsibility for remaining calm and carrying out all duties with the recognition of the threat to life and property;
- Successfully meet the Fire Department's requirements and pass entry exams;
- Work within a command structure requiring strict adherence to the following of orders;
- Work in a team environment under extremely stressful situations;
- Quickly learn and put to use new skills and knowledge brought about by rapidly changing information and/or technology;
- Learn and correctly apply routine division and department policies and procedures;
- Read, comprehend, and follow simple oral and written instructions; and to understand and apply available guidelines to varied operational requirements;
- Perform a wide variety of duties and responsibilities with accuracy and speed under the pressure of time-sensitive deadlines;
- Demonstrate integrity, ingenuity and inventiveness in the performance of assigned tasks;
- Operate a personal computer using program applications appropriate to assigned duties;
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing, with the public and other employees.

Minimum Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED equivalency; and
- Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of application;
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge and abilities necessary to perform the work.

Essential Physical Abilities

The primary duties are performed in a work environment in which the Firefighter is subject to potential personal danger. Therefore, the following physical abilities are deemed essential:

- Sufficient clarity of speech and hearing and other communication capabilities, with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Firefighter to communicate effectively, including during emergency situations which may involve a high degree of noise;
- Sufficient vision and other powers of observation, with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Firefighter to effectively operate at a fire or related emergency scene training;
- Sufficient manual dexterity with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Firefighter to operate equipment used in fire fighting training;
- Sufficient personal mobility and physical reflexes, with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the Firefighter to perform all duties involved in supporting the Fire Company and completing training.
- Ability to walk three miles while carrying a 45 lb pack.
